AN ACT PROVIDING FOR REDUCTIONS IN THE TAXATION OF SAVINGS ACCOUNTS OF PERSONS AGE SIXTY-FIVE AND OVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Clause (6) subdivision (a) of subsection B of section 3 of chapter
- 2 62 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 words "Part B Gross Income." the following: "A deduction from
- 4 Part B income, in addition to that provided by the first sentence of
- 5 this clause, of one thousand dollars on income from savings depos-
- 6 its, savings accounts, shares or share savings accounts for persons
- 7 age sixty-five and older. For married couples age Sixty-five or
- 8 older this additional deduction shall be in the amount of two
- 9 thousand dollars.
