AN ACT REQUIRING FULL DISCLOSURE ON COUNTY TAX BILLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 13 of chapter 15 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 13 of chapter 514 of the acts of 1978, is hereby
3 further amended by adding the following sentence: — The county
4 commissioners shall include in their warrants a schedule of county
5 taxes as they are apportioned among and upon the several cities
6 and towns in the county; of county taxes for preceding year and a
7 statement listing and describing the services received by the cities
8 and towns as a result of the assessment made under the provisions
9 of this section.
