AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW PROVIDING FOR INFORMATION FOR VOTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 53 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 chapter 898 of the acts of 1977, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following paragraph: —

4 If the state secretary finds that any statement made in an argu-
5 ment provided under the following section will tend to mislead the
6 voters about the effect of their votes, he may at any time amend his
7 one-sentence statement under this section accordingly.
