AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF MOTORBOAT LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (b) of section 14 of chapter 90B of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in Section 2 of Chapter 714 of the acts
3 of 1974, is hereby amended by striking out in lines two and three
4 the words, "section twelve".

1 SECTION 2. Section 14 of said Chapter 90B, as most recently
2 amended by Section 3 of Chapter 551 of the acts of 1979, is hereby
3 further amended by inserting after subsection (c) the following
4 subsection: —

5 (d) Whoever violates any provision of section twelve shall be
6 punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five nor more than one
7 hundred and fifty dollars.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
