The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A SPECIALLY TRAINED AND EQUIPPED ANTI-TERRORIST POLICE UNIT AT GENERAL EDWARD LAWRENCE LOGAN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 22 Section 9K of the Massachusetts General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the first paragraph of Section
3 9K the following new paragraph:
4 "The Commissioner shall maintain as part of the force author-
5 ized by law to be assigned to the Massachusetts Port Authority at
6 General Edward Lawrence Logan International Airport a specially
7 trained and equipped anti-terrorist police unit for the specific
8 purposes of the prevention of skyjacking of commercial aircraft,
9 for the prevention of terrorist attacks on civilians and commercial
10 air passengers and for the protection and recovery of hostages."
