AN ACT LOWERING THE AGE OF ELIGIBILITY FOR REAL ESTATE TAX ABATEMENTS FROM SEVENTY TO SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Clause 41 of Section 5 of Chapter 59 of the General Laws, as
- 2 most recently amended by Chapter 967 of the Acts of 1977, is
- 3 hereby amended by striking out in the first sentence wherever
- 4 appearing, the word "seventieth" and inserting in place thereof
- 5 "sixty-fifth",.
