In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Three.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF ADMINISTRATORS WORKING UNDER THE CONTROL OF SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 41 of chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out the second paragraph, as appearing in section 1 of
3 chapter 464 of the acts of 1972, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following paragraph: —

5 A school committee may award a contract to a superintendent of
6 schools, or to any administrator working under his supervision, for
7 a period not exceeding six years. Nothing in this section shall be
8 construed to prevent a school committee from voting to employ a
9 superintendent of schools, or from voting to employ any adminis-
10 trator working under his supervision, who has completed three or
11 more years service to serve at its discretion.
