*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The Secretary of Administration, acting for and on behalf of the  
2 Commonwealth, is hereby authorized and directed to enter into  
3 negotiations with the United States Government, for the acquisition  
4 or purchase of the Post Office Building and land located at 436  
5 Dwight Street, Springfield for use as a state office building or for  
6 such other use as the general court shall determine.
