AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO CONVEY CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF TEWKSBURY TO SAID TOWN FOR CONSERVATION PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commissioner of public health acting for and
2 in behalf of the commonwealth is hereby authorized to convey to
3 the conservation commission of the town of Tewksbury for recrea-
4 tional purposes, by a deed approved as to form by the attorney
5 general, a certain parcel of land shown on town of Tewksbury
6 assessor's map 31, lots 5 and 6, said lots being adjacent to Long
7 Pond.
