1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three mem-
2 bers of the senate, five members of the house of representatives,
3 and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby estab-
4 lished for the purpose of making an investigation and study rela-
5 tive to the eligibility requirements and procedures for the granting
6 of a real estate tax abatement under the provisions of either clause
7 seventeenth or clause forty-first of section five of chapter fifty-nine
8 of the General Laws.
