### AN ACT PROVIDING MINIMUM WAGE FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS INVOLVED IN SHELTERED WORKSHOP PROGRAMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 78A of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by chapter 513 of the acts of 1980, is hereby further  
3 amended by adding the following sentence: — Any such handi-  
4 capped person involved in a program of extended sheltered em-  
5 ployment shall be paid the minimum federal wage rate.
