AN ACT ESTABLISHING A DEADLINE FOR CHALLENGING ABSENTEE BALLOT PROCEDURES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 96 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in section 7 of chapter 404 of the acts of 1934, is hereby
3 amended by striking out, in line 3, the words "when or".

1 SECTION 2. Said section 96 of said chapter 54 is hereby fur-
2 ther amended by adding the following sentence: — Any such chal-
3 lenge must be brought within ten days after the day of the election.
