AN ACT AMENDING AGE OF OPERATION AND PREREQUISITES TO OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 8 of chapter 90 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 90 of the acts of 1982, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence and
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —

5 A junior operator's license may, under rules and regulations
6 established by the registrar, be issued a minor under eighteen years
7 of age who has attained age seventeen and six months; provided,
8 however, that said minor shall have successfully completed a writ-
9 ten examination as prescribed by the registrar and a six-month
10 probationary period of operation.
