AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN PAVEMENT MARKINGS ON CERTAIN
NUMBERED ROUTES WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commissioner of the department of public
2 works is hereby authorized to promulgate rules and regulations
3 providing for the construction and maintenance of pavement
4 markings on all numbered routes within the commonwealth which
5 are not state highways. Such work shall be done by the department
6 or by contract with outside companies.

1 SECTION 2. Funds to pay for the construction and mainte-
2 nance provided for in section one of this act shall be made available
3 by appropriation from the highway bond issue.

Section 1. The Commission on the Status of Women is hereby created, and its members shall be appointed by the President, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, to serve for a term of five years, and until their successors are appointed. The Commission shall report to the President and to the Senate at the expiration of its term, and at such other times as the President may direct.
