AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE FURTHER RETENTION OF CAMPAIGN EXPENDITURES AND CONTRIBUTION REPORTS AND STATEMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 25 of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 section 1 of chapter 151 of the acts of 1975, is hereby amended by
3 striking out the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the
4 following paragraph: —

5 The director shall retain all statements and reports filed with his
6 office under the provisions of this chapter by a candidate or com-
7 mittee for six years after the latest original entry therein or thereon.
