By Mr. Alexander of Marblehead (by request), petition of Melba I. MacDuff for legislation to prohibit pictures of lemons on dishwashing liquid products. Commerce and Labor.

AN ACT PROHIBITING PICTURES OF LEMONS ON DISHWASHING LIQUID PRODUCTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the
2 following section: —

3 *Section 328.* No person or firm shall sell or offer to sell any
4 dishwashing liquid product in a package or a container having a
5 picture or illustration depicting a lemon. Whoever violates the
6 provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more
7 than five hundred dollars.

As a result of the investigation, it was determined that the person named in the above captioned report was not a member of the House of Representatives and was not a member of the Senate.
