AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF A SPECIAL COMMISSION STUDYING CERTAIN ALCOHOL AND DRUG MISUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 22 of chapter 241 of the acts of 1982 is hereby amended
2 by striking out the second paragraph and inserting in plsce thereof
3 the following paragraph: —
4 The commission shall consist of four members of the senate,
5 seven members of the house of representatives, the commissioner
6 of education or his designee, the director of the division of
7 alcoholism within the department of public health or his designee,
8 the director of the division of drug rehabilitation within the
9 department of public health or his designee, and nine persons to be
10 appointed by the governor, of whom one shall be a member of the
11 Masachusetts Association of School Committees; one a member of
12 the Massachusetts Teachers Association, who is an active member
13 of a drug or alcohol program; one a member of the Massachusetts
14 Federal of Teachers, AFT, AFL-CIO, who is an active member of
15 a drug or alcohol program; one a member of the Massachusetts
16 Association of School Superintendents; one a member of the
17 Massachusetts Parent-Student-Teacher Association; one a parent
18 who has a child in school and is a registered nurse with at least two
19 years experience in drug or alcohol rehabilitation; one a physician
20 specializing in alcohol rehabilitation; one a certified alcohol or
21 drug counselor and one a student attending school.
