AN ACT REGULATING THE TRANSFER OF TAX DELINQUENT REAL PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Any city or town accepting the provisions of this act may by 2/3
- 2 vote of its governing body take title to and transfer any abandoned
- 3 and/or tax delinquent real property six months after title owner
- 4 received notice of said taking and transfer.
