

By Mr. McKenna of Springfield, petition of Arthur J. McKenna, Martin T. Reilly and other members of the General Court relative to the location of a certain office of the Division of Employment Security in the city of Springfield. State Administration.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LOCATION OF A CERTAIN OFFICE OF THE
DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 659 of the acts of 1982 is hereby amended by striking out
2 section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following section: —
3 *Section 1.* To provide for the acquisition by the commonwealth
4 of, and the planning and specifications for the reconstruction and
5 remodelling of the building formerly occupied by the United States
6 Government, located at 436 Dwight street in the city of Springfield,
7 and known as the Federal Building and Courthouse, the deputy
8 commissioner of the division of capital planning, in accordance with
9 the provisions of sections thirty-nine A to forty L, inclusive, of
10 chapter seven, is hereby authorized to acquire by gift, purchase,
11 devise, grant, eminent domain, rental, rental purchase or other-
12 wise, said building to be used as a state office building or for such
13 other uses as the general court shall determine; provided, however,
14 that the Springfield offices of the department of public welfare, the
15 Massachusetts rehabilitation commission, the Massachusetts
16 commission for the blind, the department of social services and
17 those offices of the division of employment security which are
18 located in the city of Springfield except the office located at 1592
19 Main street in said city shall not be located or relocated in said
20 building; and provided, further, that offices of state agencies
21 located in the cities of Chicopee, Holyoke and Westfield and the
22 towns of West Springfield and Ludlow shall not be located nor

23 relocated in said building; and the sums set forth in sections two,
24 three and four of this act, for the several purposes and subject to the
25 conditions in said sections two, three and four are hereby made
26 available, subject to the provisions of law regulating the disburse-
27 ment of public funds and the approval thereof, for said acquisitions
28 and renovation.
