In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Three.

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE THE THIRTIETH, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE TO PROVIDE FOR SUPPLEMENTING THE RESPITE CARE PROGRAM FOR THE DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in the  
2 general appropriations act and for certain new activities and proj-  
3 ects, the sums set forth in section two for the several purposes and  
4 subject to the provisions of law regulating the disbursement of  
5 public funds and the conditions pertaining to appropriations in  
6 chapter one hundred and ninety-one of the acts of nineteen  
7 hundred and eighty-two, for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth,  
8 nineteen hundred and eighty-three for such period as may be  
9 specified, the sums so appropriated to be in addition to any  
10 amounts available for the purpose.
