### AN ACT RELATIVE TO VENUE FOR CERTAIN SEXUAL OFFENSES WITH FEEBLEMINDED PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking  
2 out section 24A, as amended by section 5 of chapter 474 of the acts  
3 of 1974, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —  
4 *Section 24A.* If, in connection with the alleged commission of a  
5 crime described in section thirteen B, thirteen F, thirteen H,  
6 twenty-two, twenty-two A, twenty-three, twenty-four or twenty-  
7 four B or section five of chapter two hundred and seventy-two, the  
8 person against whom said crime is alleged to have been committed  
9 has been conveyed from one county or judicial district into  
10 another, said crime may be alleged to have been committed, and  
11 may be prosecuted and punished, in the county or judicial district  
12 where committed or from which such person was so conveyed.
