AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF CHESTERFIELD TO ESTABLISH A REVOLVING FUND FOR THE OPENING AND CLOSING OF GRAVES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The town of Chesterfield is hereby authorized to establish in the
2 town treasury a revolving fund in which shall be deposited all
3 receipts received for the opening and closing of graves. Any and all
4 such funds received by the town treasurer shall be kept separate
5 from any other moneys, funds or property of said town, and the
6 principal and interest thereof shall be expended at the direction of
7 the cemetery superintendent and the board of selectmen and with-
8 out further appropriation for the opening and closing of graves,
9 notwithstanding the provisions of section fifty-three of chapter
10 forty-four of the General Laws; provided, however, that the town
11 treasurer shall submit annually an audit of said revolving fund to
12 the board of selectmen of said town for its approval and a copy of
13 said audit shall be submitted to the director of the bureau of
14 accounts; and provided further that said revolving fund shall not
15 exceed the sum of twelve hundred dollars.
