AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE STATE TREASURER TO PAY A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO THE CITY OF MEDFORD TO ENABLE SAID CITY TO SATISFY AN OUTSTANDING JUDGEMENT.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat
2 its purpose, which is to immediately enable the state treasurer to
3 pay a certain sum of money to the city of Medford, therefore it is
4 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the imme-
5 diate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of enabling the city of Medford to
2 satisfy an outstanding judgement, the state treasurer is hereby
3 authorized and directed to pay to said city the sum of two million
4 eight hundred thousand dollars, which shall be in addition to all
5 other sums said city shall be entitled to receive from the common-
6 wealth. Said amount shall be repaid to the commonwealth in equal
7 installments of two hundred and eighty thousand dollars over a
8 period of ten years commencing with fiscal year nineteen hundred
9 and eighty-five by way of a deduction of said amount from the first
10 local aid distribution said city is entitled to receive in each of said
11 years.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of
2 section one, two million eight hundred thousand dollars is hereby
3 appropriated from the Local Aid Fund.
