

Time of taking effect.

SECTION 2. The increase in salary provided for by this act shall not take effect until an appropriation has been made sufficient to cover the same, and then as of the first day of January of the current year.

*Chap.346* AN ACT TO FIX THE COMPENSATION OF THE PAGES EMPLOYED BY THE SERGEANT-AT-ARMS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Pages employed by sergeant-at-arms, compensation fixed.

Beginning with January first, nineteen hundred and twenty, the pages in the employ of the sergeant-at-arms shall receive as compensation for services rendered during the regular session of the general court the sum of six hundred dollars each.

*Chap.347* AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARIES OF THE PRESENT CLERKS OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Clerks of senate and house of representatives, salaries established.

SECTION 1. The annual salary of Henry D. Coolidge, as clerk of the senate, and the annual salary of James W. Kimball, as clerk of the house of representatives, shall each be five thousand dollars.

Time of taking effect.

SECTION 2. This act shall not take effect until a sufficient appropriation therefor is made at the current session of the general court, and then as of the first day of June in the current year.

*Chap.348* AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARIES OF THE PRESENT ASSISTANT CLERKS OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Assistant clerks of senate and house of representatives, salaries established.

SECTION 1. The annual salary of William H. Sanger, as assistant clerk of the senate, and the annual salary of Frank E. Bridgman, as assistant clerk of the house of representatives, shall each be thirty-five hundred dollars.

Time of taking effect.

SECTION 2. This act shall not take effect until a sufficient appropriation therefor is made at the current session of the general court, and then as of the first day of June in the current year.
