AN ACT AUTHORIZING RICHARD HIGGINS TO TAKE A CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR POLICE OFFICER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the registration deadline of Sep-
2 tember 9, 1983, Richard Higgins shall be eligible to apply for and
3 take the next open competitive examination for appointment to the
4 position of police officer; and provided he meets all other require-
5 ments, he shall be eligible for certification and appointment to said
6 position.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
