

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARIES OF THE DEPUTY WARDEN OF THE STATE PRISON AND THE DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT OF THE MASSACHUSETTS REFORMATORY. *Chap.353*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The annual salaries of the deputy warden of the state prison and of the deputy superintendent of the Massachusetts reformatory shall each be twenty-five hundred dollars a year.

Deputy warden of state prison and deputy superintendent of Massachusetts reformatory, salaries established. Time of taking effect.

SECTION 2. This act shall not take effect until a sufficient appropriation therefor is made at the current session of the general court, and then as of the first day of June in the current year.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PROCURING OF PORTRAITS OF THE GOVERNORS OF THE COMMONWEALTH. *Chap.354*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Chapter ten of the Revised Laws is hereby amended by striking out section twenty-two and substituting the following: — *Section 22.* The governor, with the advice and consent of the counsel, may expend, for the purpose of procuring portraits of the governors of the commonwealth who shall have held office subsequent to the fourth day of May, nineteen hundred, a sum not exceeding three thousand dollars for each portrait, and the portraits so procured shall be hung in the state house under the direction of the art commission.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY OF THE PRESENT CHAPLAIN AT THE MASSACHUSETTS REFORMATORY. *Chap.355*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The salary of Robert Walker, the chaplain at the Massachusetts reformatory, shall be twenty-seven hundred and fifty dollars a year.

Chaplain at Massachusetts reformatory, salary established.

SECTION 2. This act shall not take effect until a sufficient appropriation therefor is made at the current session of the general court, and then as of the first day of June in the current year.
