
TO THE HONORABLE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF COMMISSIONED OFFICERS IN THE DIVISION OF STATE POLICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 22 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 Section 9T, as enacted by Chapter 655 of the Acts of 1979, in its
3 entirety, and inserting in its place the following:
4 *Section 9T.* Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 45 and
5 46 of Chapter 30 of the General Laws, each commissioned officer
6 in the Division of State Police shall receive a base salary nine
7 percent greater than the regular salary payable to the next subor-
8 dinate grade in accordance with a schedule submitted by the
9 Commissioner of Administration to the House and Senate Com-
10 mittees on Ways and Means. The Commissioner of Administra-
11 tion in consultation with the Commissioner of Public Safety shall
12 establish procedures for a review of said salary schedule and shall
13 submit recommendations for adjustments in subsequent years in
14 the House and Senate Committees on Ways and Means.
