4 appointed by the governor within thirty days of the passage of this  
5 act, one member appointed by the Senate President, one member  
6 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and  
7 two members appointed by the county commissioners association.  
8     The commission shall file their recommendations and any leg-  
9 islation with the Senate and House Clerks on or before the first  
10 Wednesday in December 1994.
