AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A TUITION WAIVER PROGRAM FOR HUMAN SERVICE WORKERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section seven of chapter 15A of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following new paragraph: —
- 3 The board of regents shall institute a program to allow any full
- 4 time human service worker employed by an agency that receives
- 5 funding from an 07 state contract, or worker employed by a
- 6 provider agency subcontracting with such an agency, to attend
- 7 courses at state institutions of higher education in the Common-
- 8 wealth at no tuition cost.
