AN ACT REQUIRING THE ONE SENTENCE STATEMENT REQUIRED BY LAW IN THE INFORMATION TO VOTERS TO BE PLACED ON THE STATE ELECTION BALLOT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 42 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in
3 line 59 after the word "like" the following: — ; provided, how-
4 ever, the fair, concise summary of any measure submitted to the
5 voters under the provisions of Article XLVIII of the Amendments
6 to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, shall
7 be immediately followed on the ballot by the one-sentence state-
8 ment describing the effect of a yes or no vote, prepared as
9 required by section fifty-three.
