AN ACT RELATIVE TO ELECTRIC AND GAS COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
2 voters of any city or town which is serviced by any two electric or
3 gas companies may vote, at a special town meeting, to determine
4 which electric or gas company shall be franchised to service the
5 entire city or town.

6 The Department of Public Utilities shall determine the value of
7 such utility subject to conveyance which occurs pursuant to this
8 act.
