AN ACT PROVING CERTAIN PERSONNEL FOR THE DISTRICT COURT OF WESTERN WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 10 of Chapter 218
2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the line
3 "fourth district court of Plymouth" the following line: — district
4 court of Western Worcester.

1 SECTION 2. Section 69 of chapter 218 is hereby amended by
2 adding at the end thereof the following: — no less than ten per-
3 sons shall be employed to provide such clerical assistance in the
4 district court of Western Worcester.

1 SECTION 3. Section 83 of Chapter 276 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence thereof the
3 following: — No less than five probation officers shall be
4 assigned to the district court of Western Worcester.

1 SECTION 4. The first paragraph of section eighty-eight of
2 Chapter 276 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the
3 following: — It shall be deemed necessary to employ no less than
4 five persons to provide such assistance in the district court of
5 Western Worcester.
