AN ACT PERMITTING NON-RESIDENTS TO SERVE AS VOLUNTARY ADMINISTRATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. General Laws Chapter 195 Section 16 as most
2 recently amended by Chapter 160 section 1 of the Acts of 1987 is
3 hereby amended by striking the words, "and an inhabitant of the
4 commonwealth" in line seven thereof.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 16 of Chapter 195 is further amend-
2 ed by adding the following sentence at line thirty-two thereof,
3 after the word "intestacy.": — If the administrator resides outside
4 the commonwealth he shall appoint a resident agent to represent
5 him within the commonwealth.
