AN ACT REQUIRING OPERATOR IDENTIFICATION ON CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 7D of chapter 90 of the General
2 Laws as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amend-
3 ed by adding the following sentence: — “All such motor vehicles
4 shall display, on the vehicle, a sign or marker, identifying the
5 owner, owner contractor, or name of the company contracted with
6 to operate said vehicle.”
