AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BUILDING ON THE GROUNDS OF BORDERLAND STATE PARK AS THE LAWRENCE NEWCOMBE VISITORS CENTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The building located on the grounds of Borderland State Park
- 2 in Easton and Sharon, known as the Visitors Center shall be
- 3 designated and known as the Lawrence Newcombe Visitors
- 4 Center. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be
- 5 attached thereto by the department of environmental management
- 6 in compliance with the standards of said department.
