

ACTS, 1984. - Chaps. 2, 3.

Chap. 2. AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF
TREASURER-COLLECTOR OF TAXES IN THE
TOWN OF HOPEDALE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The office of treasurer-collector in the town of Hopedale is hereby established. Said treasurer-collector of taxes shall be appointed by the board of selectmen of said town for a term not to exceed three years and shall perform all duties hereinbefore performed by the treasurer and tax collector of said town and shall have such other powers and duties as may from time to time be established. Said town may establish by by-law such qualifications for such office as deemed necessary and appropriate. Any vacancy in said office shall be filled in like manner for the unexpired portion of such term. Upon the appointment and qualification of said treasurer-collector, the terms of office of the persons holding the offices of treasurer and collector of taxes shall terminate.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 3. AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE
FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE THIRTIETH, NINE-
TEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FOUR TO PROVIDE
FOR SUPPLEMENTING A CERTAIN EXISTING
APPROPRIATION AND FOR A CERTAIN NEW
ACTIVITY AND PROJECT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in the general appropriation act and for certain new activities and projects, the sums set forth in section two for the several purposes and subject to the provisions of law regulating the disbursement of public funds and the conditions pertaining to appropriations in chapter two hundred and eighty-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and eighty-three, for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty-four or for such period as may be specified, the sums so appropriated to be in addition to any amounts available for the purpose.

SECTION 3. Chapter 723 of the acts of 1983 is hereby amended by striking out section 9V and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 9V. A portion of the funds provided in sections nine to nine T, inclusive, of this act, not to exceed six per cent of any section, may be used for the costs of the commonwealth associated with the acquisition or development of property or the administration of the grant programs set forth in said sections. Such associated costs may include the cost of legal services, inspections, audits, appraisals, design, engineering, and planning. No amounts authorized in sections nine to nine T, inclusive, of this act shall be used for the payment of any salaries of permanent or temporary employees of the commonwealth.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
