AN ACT TO HELP THE HOMELESS IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of revenue is directed to establish a voluntary
2 check off fee on the annual state income tax return enabling
3 Massachusetts citizens receiving tax refunds to contribute
4 two dollars to a fund to help reduce homelessness in the
5 Commonwealth.

6 Such funds shall be deposited in a special account set up under
7 and administered by the executive office of human services for the
8 sole purpose of providing shelter and housing for the homeless.
