**AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CERTAIN LAND AT THE LAWRENCE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT.**

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to permit the sale of certain land at  
3 the Lawrence Municipal Airport which would foster the economic  
4 development of the Greater Lawrence communities, therefore it is  
5 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the public  
6 convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section fifteen  
2 of chapter forty or of any other general or special law to the  
3 contrary, the provisions of the second paragraph of section fifteen  
4 of chapter forty shall not apply to the sale by the City of Lawrence  
5 or by the Lawrence Airport Commission of property situated  
6 within the territorial limits of the Town of North Andover under  
7 a certain purchase and sale agreement, effective as of  
8 October 27, 1993, by and between the City of Lawrence and  
9 Pencor, Inc., as such agreement may be amended from time to  
10 time.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
