AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXPENDITURE OF CERTAIN SURPLUS BOND PROCEEDS BY THE TOWN OF HOPKINTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter forty-
2 four of section twenty of the General Laws, as the town of
3 Hopkinton is hereby authorized to appropriate, for any lawful pur-
4 pose, sixty-one thousand eight hundred and fifteen dollars and
5 forty-six cents, from the balance of bond proceeds issued prior to
6 nineteen hundred and eighty-nine of indeterminate origin.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
