In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO TEACHER RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation
2 to the contrary, any public school teacher may purchase up to five
3 years creditable service towards their retirement if said teacher
4 contributed up to five years into social security. Said individual
5 may before the date any retirement allowance becomes effective
6 pay into the annuity savings fund of the system, upon such terms
7 and conditions as the retirement board may prescribe, an amount
8 equal to that which would have been withheld as regular deduc-
9 tions from his regular compensation for such previous period had
10 such service been rendered in a public school of the common-
11 wealth and had he been a member of the teacher's retirement sys-
12 tem during the period such other employment was rendered.
