AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR REIMBURSEMENT TO CITIES AND TOWNS FOR EDUCATIONAL EXPENSES RELATED TO CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of Chapter 11D of the Acts of 1993, is hereby
2 amended by inserting after item 7028-0302 the following item:

7028-0303 For reimbursement to cities and towns for the expense of state mandated special education expenses pursuant to Chapter 71B of the General Laws and Chapter 766 of the Acts of 1972 who have transferred to the school department of another city or town after September 1, 1993.
