AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF CERTAIN LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Group 2 of paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of
2 section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most recently
3 amended by section 1 of chapter 100 of the acts of 1993, is hereby
4 further amended by striking out the words “; University of Massa-
5 chusetts police.”

1 SECTION 2. Group 4 of said paragraph (g) of said subdivi-
2 sion (2) of said section 3 of said chapter 32, as most recently
3 amended by chapter 139 of the acts of 1993, is hereby further
4 amended by inserting after the words “correctional facilities” the
5 following words:— ; police officers of the University of Massa-
6 chusetts; district attorneys and assistant district attorneys.
