AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR ANTONETTE TOCCHIO,  
AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

1     *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat  
2 its purpose, which is to immediately establish a sick leave bank for  
3 a certain employee of the department of education, therefore it is  
4 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the  
5 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1     Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law,  
2 rule or regulation to the contrary, the department of education  
3 is hereby authorized and directed to establish a sick leave bank  
4 for Antonette Tocchio, an employee of said department. Any  
5 employee of said department may voluntarily contribute one or  
6 more of his sick, personal or vacation days to said sick leave bank  
7 for use by said Antonette Tocchio.
