AN ACT REGARDING TAX ABATEMENT FEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary, an appeal of Board of Assessors regarding a real
3 estate tax abatement may be only heard by the Appellate Tax
4 Board.
