AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING HAZARDOUS WASTE TREATMENT FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 150B of Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1990 Official Edition, and as amended by Chapter 23 of the
3 Acts of 1992, is hereby further amended in paragraph 11, by
4 adding after the first sentence the following new text: —

5 “Such facilities, however, shall be subject to reasonable rules
6 and regulations made by local boards of health pursuant to
7 Chapter 111, and which may include provisions relative to facility
8 maintenance procedures, operating procedurse and practices, local
9 enforcement of state statutes and regulations governing such facil-
10 ities, monitoring and inspection procedures, practices and
11 standards necessary to assure that the facility will be operated in a
12 manner which will not be injurious to the public health and safety
13 or the environment.”
