

By Mr. Manning of Milton, petition of M. Joseph Manning relative to extending the time for withdrawal of additional deductions paid into the annuity savings fund of contributory retirement systems. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT FURTHER EXTENDING THE TIME FOR WITHDRAWAL OF ADDITIONAL DEDUCTIONS PAID INTO THE ANNUITY SAVINGS FUND OF CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEMS.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat
2 its purpose, which is to allow forthwith certain public employees to
3 withdraw pension deductions voluntarily paid into the annuity sav-
4 ings fund of contributory retirement systems, therefore it is hereby
5 declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate
6 preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 656 of the acts of 1954 is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 2, as most recently amended by Chapter 716 of the
3 acts of 1977, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section:—

5 Section 2. Withdrawal of accumulated additional deductions
6 under paragraph (a) of subdivision (1) of section twenty-two of
7 chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, as amended by section
8 one, shall be made upon written application to the board made
9 prior to January first, nineteen hundred and ninety-five.
