AN ACT TO CLARIFY CONTINUOUS SERVICE IN A RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32 of Section 22 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1986 Official Edition, is amended in subsection (1)(b½) by
3 adding at the end of the subsection the following sentence:—
4 (1)(b½) For the purposes of this subsection any member in service
5 before January 1, 1979, who was laid off because of reduction in
6 force caused by budget cuts, whether or not he or she withdrew
7 contributions to the retirement fund upon reinstatement to active
8 service shall be considered to have maintained continuous active
9 service in the retirement system.
