RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND THEIR ACTIVITIES IN POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three mem-
2 bers of the Senate, six members of the House of Representatives
3 and two persons to be appointed by the Governor, is hereby estab-
4 lished for the purpose of making an investigation and study rela-
5 tive to employees of the Commonwealth and their activities in
6 political campaigns.

7 Said commission shall report to the House of Representatives
8 the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations,
9 if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its rec-
10 ommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the
11 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
12 December, nineteen hundred and ninety-four.
