AN ACT RELATIVE TO SPECIAL OFFICERS IN COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter one hundred forty-seven, section ten G is hereby
- 2 repealed and replaced by the following section: —
- 3 The commissioner of Public Safety may, upon such reasonable
- 4 terms and conditions as may be prescribed by him, at the request
- 5 of an officer of a college or university, appoint employees of such
- 6 college or university as special police officers. Such special offi-
- 7 cers shall serve for three years subject to removal by the commis-
- 8 sioner.
- 9 Such special officers shall, while on official duty, have the
- 10 powers of an arrest for any rule or regulation by such college or
- 11 university. Nothing in this section shall give or authorize such
- 12 special officer the right to enforce any statute or local ordinance
- 13 on any public ways or whatever.
