AN ACT RELATIVE TO MOTOR VEHICLE SECURITY SYSTEMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 47 of chapter 147 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 first paragraph the following:—

4 “Within six months after the passage of this act, all motor vehi-
5 cles which are registered in the commonwealth which are
6 equipped with security systems containing an audible alarm shall
7 also be equipped with a device which shall be adjusted so that any
8 audible emissions designed to signal to persons outside the
9 vehicle shall cease after two minutes of operation.”
